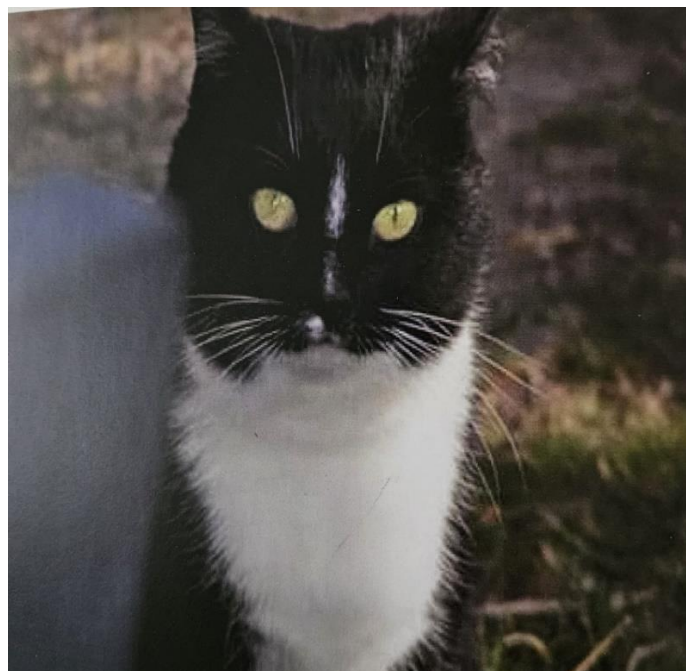
Dear Heloise

Reflections

Looking back on my life, I have seen so many different faces and with those faces different identities. In 2009, a man I met and later started dating gave me a nickname, "laylo189." What it meant was this. "Laylo" meant that I just was rarely seen (especially when I used meth, I "laid low", never ran around, just stay home). "189" meant: 1 was/is my normal personality, 8 was the various personalities that would emerge when high, and 9 was the personalities (1+8) that came to life, which was violent, full of anger, rage, hate, the personality that you didn't want to ever see. All this is true. I never knew who I was. Lost for 65 years. I hate who I had become. What happened? Where did I go? And will I ever be me?

I lost me when I was in 2nd grade. Maybe this is hard to believe but it's true. I ran away from home twice when I was in 2nd grade. Why? One reason is because I never was good enough for my parents. My older brother (older by 1 year), was a straight A student. I was not. I always heard from my dad and my teachers, "Why can't you be like your brother? What is wrong with you?" Second reason is that I was disciplined by my dad a LOT. My dad had two leather belts, one a skinny belt and the other a bit wider. The skinny belt was



used on me more than the other. I would have welts on me from my upper legs to my behind. I hated it. The other ways my dad would abuse me physically is by using his pointer finger and poke at my sternum while yelling at me. Or he would grab both my wrists and hold them together using only one of his hands and not let go until he was done, yelling at me, and occasionally he would grab the hair on the back of my head and pull it while dragging me either to my room or to the master bedroom, sometimes pulling out some of my hair. Always, I heard from my dad these words. "You will never be anything, you will never be a good worker, or a good wife, or mother. You will never succeed in anything. You are a failure."

Growing up my parents had me tested the first few weeks of every school year for mental retardation. One year, one of the school counsellors told my parents that I was not mentally retarded, that I gave up on learning because of emotional issues. My parents didn't believe her.

So from a young age I started having depression, and anxiety or fear was beginning. My mom never helped me or protected me. She was always silent, blind, or...

I talk and everyone doesn't reply.

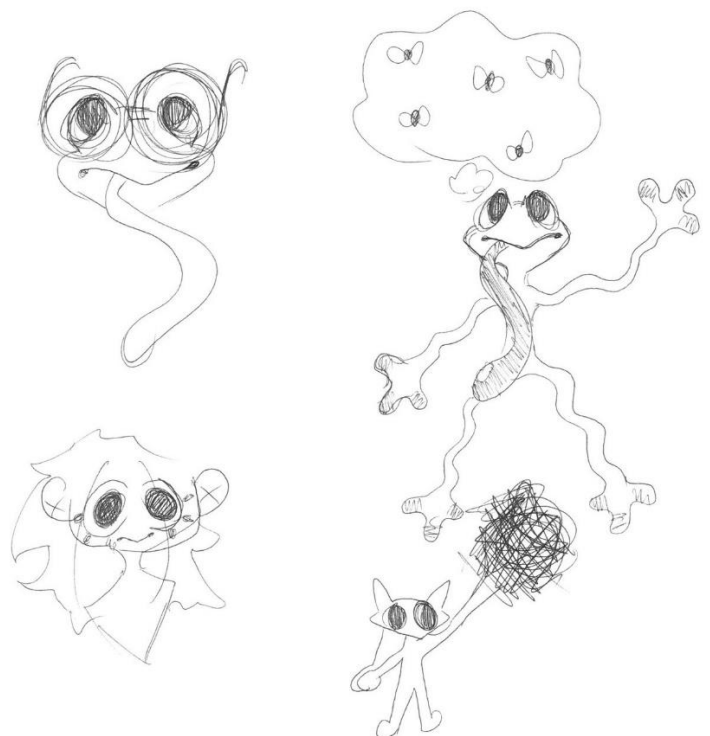


I cry and no one seems to hear me.

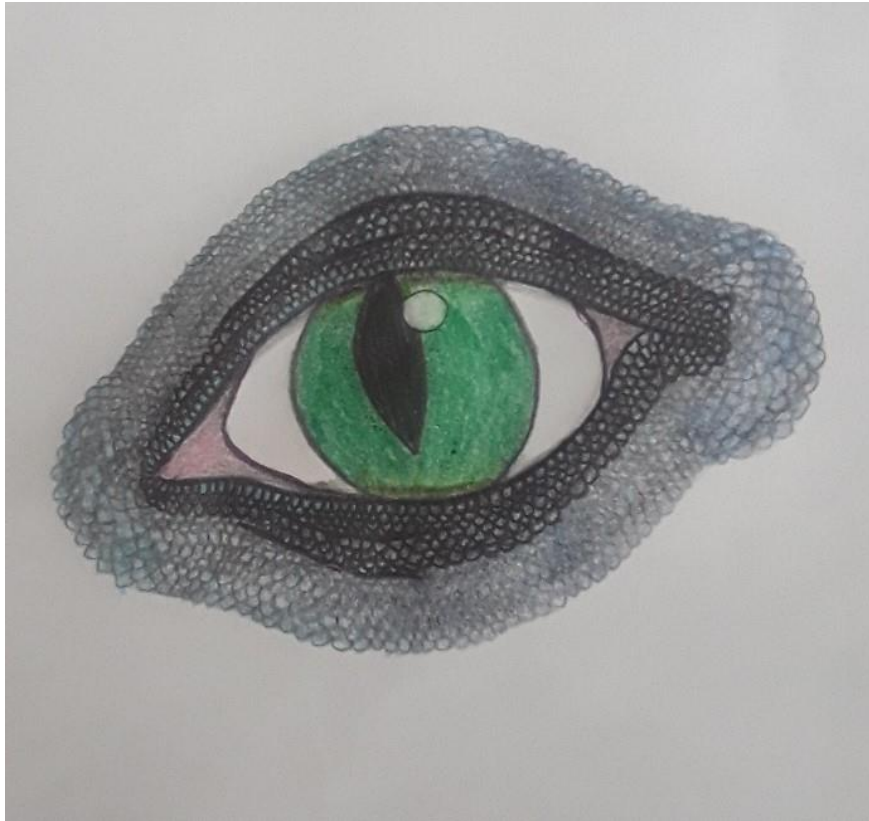

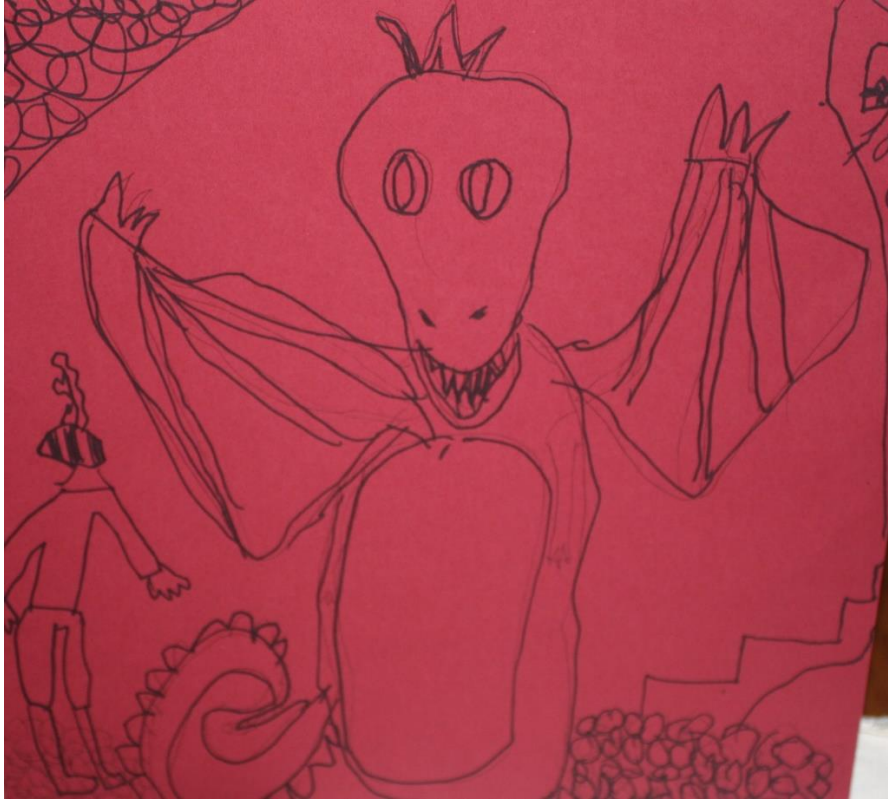

On February 10 2024 it is Chinese New Year, the Year of the “WOODEN DRAGON”.

It is important to read about the personality, traits, and character of dragons, in particular the ‘Wood Dragon.’ That’s why I’m writing about Dragon’s symbolism, totems, personalities, traits, character. Also to what influences us humans and the world so I can understand the forces of the year 2024 to better manage oneself with understandings. The more you know, the more you honor the dragon totem. It is communication and relationship for a successful year 2024.

Mystical Dragon to Shine. We all enter the “Lunar Year” on February 10 2024 as “Year of the Wood Dragon”, which concludes on January 28, 2025. Dragon Elemental comes once every 60 years. Chinese Dragons are Mythological Creatures that are composed of 9 Animals: Neck of a Snake, Horns of a Deer, Head of an Ox, Ears of a Bull, Mouth of a Crocodile, Eyes of Demon, Paws of a Tiger, Claws of an Eagle, and Scales of a Carp Fish. Chinese Dragons dwell in lakes, rivers, and seas. They can soar into the sky due to a special bump on their head. They have attributes of water rain deity, and have been linked to rain since early times.

Dragons are powerful vital creatures and symbols in the Chinese Zodiac. Dragon is the Fifth Animal in Chinese Zodiac.

Chinese Lore of Zodiacs:

The Emperor of China (The Jade Emperor, Greatest Immortal, around 2600 BC) was making a calendar. He therefore summoned 'All Creatures On Earth' to participate in a race. The first 12 Animals in the race to reach the finish line became the 12 Astrology Zodiac Signs. “Dragon” is the most powerful epic astrological zodiac sign.

Chinese Zodiac Dragons Represent Power and Wealth. They symbolize Emperor of China and Imperial Power. All Dragons control all forms of the Water element: water we drink, rivers, oceans, creeks, streams, lakes, ponds, rain, floods, and hurricanes. Dragons have Legendary Success, Self-Confidence. They are Guardians, Thinkers, Seers, Shamans. They Realize Goals, have Good Luck,



are Achieving, have Money. Dragons are pure strength and will. Dragons are the Ancient Mysteries and know the magick of ancient times. Chinese Astrology states the whole reason why Dragons were born is karmic, True Will Karmic Path (why they Incarnated on earth this life-time) and settling debts (that they are owed or that they owe). The Wood Dragon is a thinker. Dragons are the oldest souls that are holders of the sacred symbols.

Dragon Totems:

They belong to those who think, act, with intense clarity and purpose. When you need Strength or Leadership, call in a Dragon as your Power Totem, or as your Power Animal. Dragon teaches you responsibility for one's soul, and to live a life of honor. Dragons are great motivators, dreamers, and very enlightened sacred beings. They are very ancient beings and imposing symbols, epic beings.

In the Far-East, the Dragon symbolizes authority of the Emperor, who was the dreamer for the entire country he rules. Dragons rule the elements and take whatever form they want, they are Shapeshifters. Dragons have mastery of metaphysical shape-shifting, transforming into many different animals, elements. Their power abilities are equal to a Shaman's skill levels. Dragons are Shamans. Dragons can enter dreaming, they are Dreamers. Dragon symbolism is primordial, natural forces on all planes of existence, longevity, and ancient magicks (much of which have been lost to time). Through time, through lore, the ancient old battles between knights and dragons represent the inner struggle of human-beings coming to terms with their spiritual nature, and their divine nature.

In the Art of Feng Shui, Dragons symbolize good luck, good fortune, growth, development. Feng Shui Element is used to adjust the energy of a space if anything is off balance.

In Europe:

In Old Europe, Dragons represent ability to rise over circumstances and see things clearly. The European Dragons have strong tendencies, are benevolent, and only harm when evil rears its ugly head. Celtic Dragon Symbols are associated with all 4-Directions and Cardinal Directions (Cardinal Points, Compass Points) east, south, west and north. To the Druids, Dragons represented vitality, the psychic self, ancient wisdom and the power of creation itself. There are stories of Dragons protecting the secret and sacred entry-ways to other realms. Celtic Realms Ley Lines are called Dragon Lines. This ties



Dragons to Geomancy and the forces that connect all things on the Earth together. Druids/Celts thought that Stonehenge to have been the ancient resting ground for traveling dragons. Gives the phrase "Ley Of The Land" whole new meaning doesn't it? The Anglo Saxon word for dragons means CLEAR SEER. This implies that the Celts considered the Dragons as Prophets and true seers with great wisdom. Celts considered seeing a Dragon as a great omen of good health and plentiful harvest. In Modern Times, the Dragons are respected akin to the Gods as protector of Mother Earth.

Dragons Guides and Spirit:

Dragons symbolize Dignity, enthusiasm, intellect, authority, dreaming, guide. They guide towards enlightenment, brilliance and teaches us finding your inner voice, hear me roar, being heard and understood. All Dragons, no matter the type, are fearless, not afraid of anything, think act speak quickly, are Old soul, very wise, passionate, humorous, and desire to rise beyond all circumstances. Dragons are very mysterious, they represent the Great Mystery. Dragons are connected to Healing Stones, Standing Stones (i.e. Stonehenge, Power Stones, and Ancestor Realm). They also solve problems, even giant problems, and are goal oriented. Dragons are an epic totem and power animal. Calling on Dragon Medicine as Your Power Animal is key to the supernatural and the realm of true magick. Dragon-Spirits have alchemical power. Dragon protects you when you work for greatest good, but it's bad to mis-use Dragon. Mystical lure will sweep you off your feet!

Wood Element - WOOD (WU XING):

Honor Ruling Element Wood.

There are Five Main Elements: Gold-(Metal), Wood, Water, Earth, and Fire. The Wood Element is one that seeks ways to expand and grow. Woods marks the beginning of life, symbolizes dawn, spring-time, buds, sensuality, and fecundity. In Chinese Philosophy, WOOD sometimes translated as TREE. It is the growing of the matter (OR) the matter growing stage of Wood. The first phase of WU XING when observing or discussing movement or growth. Wood is the lesser Yang Character of the Five Elements, giving birth to Fire. It stands for Springtime, The East (East is agency), the planet Jupiter, the Color Green, Windy Weather, and the Azure Dragon (Qing Long) in four symbols. Blue and Cyan-Type Colors represent WOOD. Characteristics are growth, kindness, vitality. Wood Energy is related to flexibility, also human kindness. Wood Represents: decreasing blood pressure and heart rate, reducing stress, wellness.

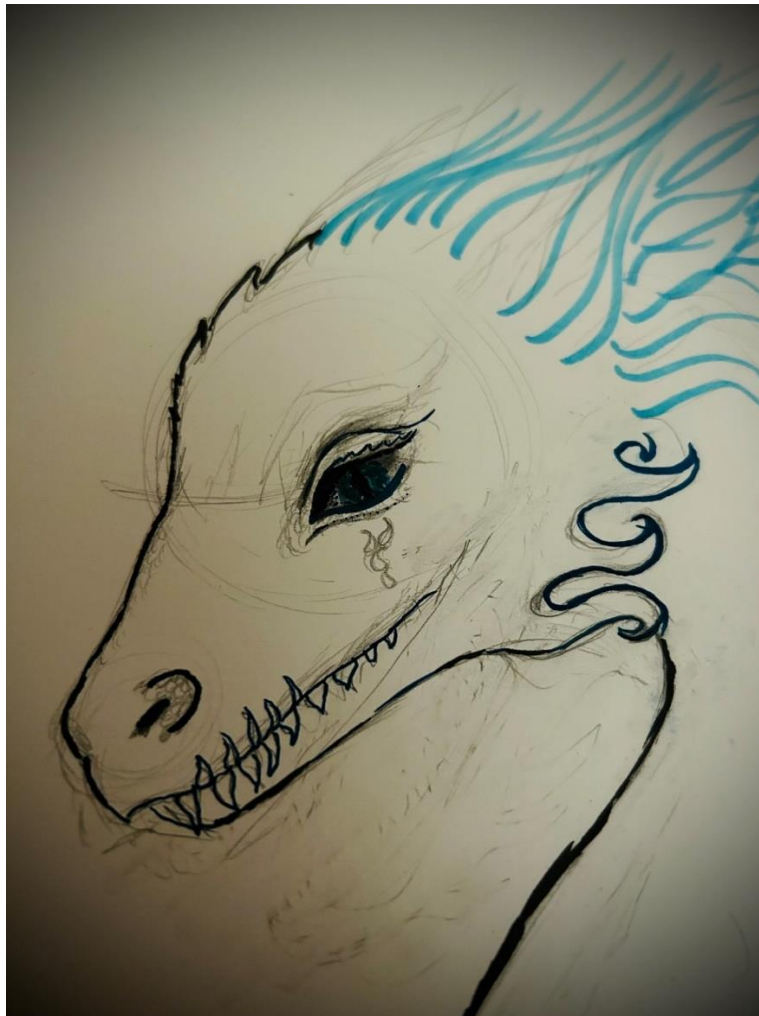

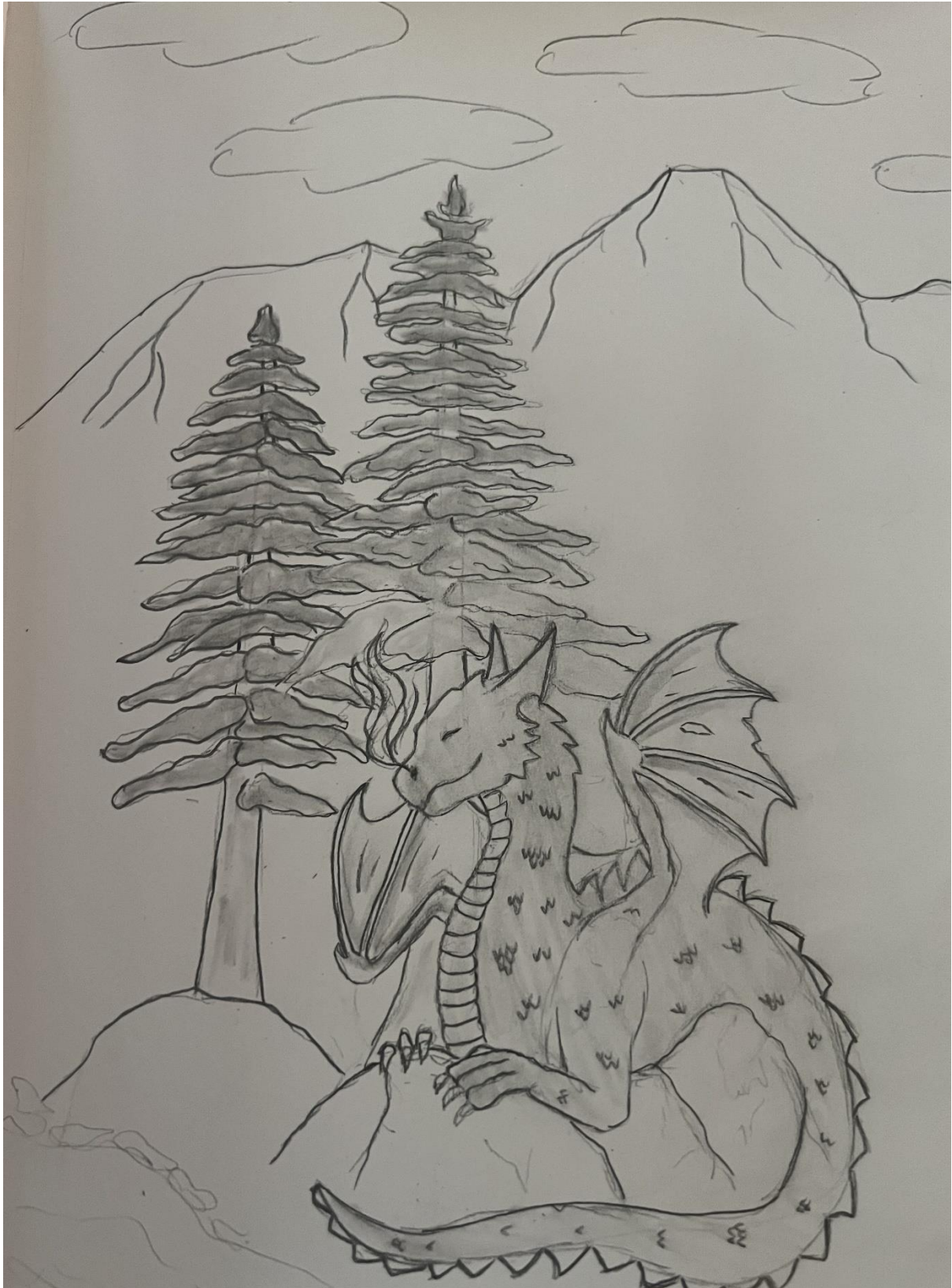
