**#T10001**

Compact plants produce paste-type tomatoes resistant to Verticillium and Fusarium wilts. Meaty interiors and few seeds.

**San Marzano**  
**#T10002**

This heirloom tomato is a favorite for sauces and canning. The long, blocky fruits mature with a small, discreet seed cavity that can be scooped out, leaving all meat. This means much less boiling to get a first class paste. The shape is also good for canning, and excellent for drying.

**Large Cherry**  
**#T10003**

Large plants, heavy yields, and great flavor. Cherry tomatoes are around 1 oz in size and turn a deep red at full maturity. Drought tolerant and resistant to fusarium wilt. A fast grower with perfect trusses of tomatoes. Looks picture perfect in the garden.



**Sweetie Cherry**  
**#T10004**

This organic, perfect, cherry tomato has classic sweet flavor. You may eat so many right in the garden, that it will be hard to get them into the house for salads! Large numbers of 3/4" to 1" fruit are produced in grape-like clusters on 2 foot tall plants. Even though the plants are indeterminate, the plants may be grown in containers on a sunny patio, deck, or balcony. As the plants continue to grow until fall frost, they will likely require a stake, small cage, or some sort of support.



**Yellow Pear**  
**#T10005**

Rampant indeterminate vines produce clusters of small yellow pear-shaped fruits. Heirloom from 1805 with a mild flavor. Great eye appeal for fresh eating.

**JoJo Cherry**  
**#T10006**

Indeterminate vigorous vines that need trellising or support with abundant clusters of small 1/2" fruit that are super sweet. Hybrid that is being stabilized into an open pollinated variety. This means there is some variation among plants but it is a fan favorite with my customers.

**Gold Nugget  
Cherry

Determinate - Produces amazing quantities of small 1 oz cherry tomatoes that taste like you just kissed the sun. Sweet, fruity, thin skin, and low acid. Gold nuggets is the close relative to sun sugar and sungold tomatoes.



**Chocolate Cherry  
#T10008**

Excellent purple cherry tomato with big tomato flavor. Fruits borne in clusters of 8 are 1" across, have a thin skin and a pleasant balance between juicy and solid. Color is a rich red to brown Mahogany. Relatively compact plants require some support but don't grow too crazy so they would be suitable to container growing. Indeterminate.



**Dakota Gold  
Beefsteak

Classic beefsteak shape can grow up to 2 lbs. Light yellow/golden with a pink blush in the center has sweet fruity flavor. Indeterminate.

**Brandywine

The quintessential heirloom tomato that sets the standard all other tomatoes are held against. Magnificent classic tomato flavor cannot be beat. Large pink fruit on potato leaf plants. This was my Granny's favorite.

**Cherokee Purple

This tomato is loved for the deep smoky but sweet complex old-time tomato flavor. Large fruit are deep red to purple inside. Fan favorite.

**Green Zebra  
#T10012**

Beautiful chartreuse with deep lime-green stripes, very attractive. Flesh is bright green and very rich tasting, sweet with a sharp bite to it (just too good to describe!). Yield is excellent. Around 3 ounces.

**Marvel Stripe**  
**#T10013**

Heirloom with strong, climbing vines bearing large sunny gold fruits shot through with rose-red, giving them a beautiful marbled effect. Flavor is mild, sweet & smooth.

Originally from the Zapotec peoples of Mexico. Produces large 10-16 ounce fruits on indeterminate vines. Fruits are yellow, orange with a lobed, pleated shape, and very few seeds. Complex, fruity and tasty.

**Japanese Black Trifele**  
**#T10014**

This beauty is the shape of a Bartlett pear. Red-brick color with green shoulders, then purple black at the base. Approx 3" long and 8-12 ounces in weight. Determinate potato leaf plants bred in Russia with firm meaty texture and complex smooth flavor.

**Oregon Spring**  
**#T10015**

Suitable for growing in containers, garden plots, raised beds, greenhouses. Resistant to Verticillium Wilt. Oregon Spring tomato plants produce clusters of 4-inch fruits (6-7 oz) on vines with a compact, determinate growth habit. They are an excellent choice for growers with limited garden space or those growing in containers or raised beds.

**Moonglow**

Uniform bright orange globes with solid flesh, few seeds, and mild sweetness. Excellent keeper. Medium slicing size.

**Celebration**  
**#T10017**

A hybrid tomato variety that is disease-resistant, vigorous, and produces large, globe-shaped fruits that are crack-resistant and weigh around 8 ounces at maturity. This variety has a determinate growth habit that produces a large number of tomatoes in the spring and summer.

**Beefsteak**  
**#T10018**

Indeterminate - The Beefsteak tomato is a large variety that is grown for slicing. The fruits are very meaty and have small seed cavities. A great tomato for sauces, plain eating, salads, burgers, sandwiches, and even grilling!

**Early Girl**

A longtime early favorite, Early Girl produces heavy yields of full-flavored, 4–6 oz. tomatoes. Extreme tolerance to drought and blossom end rot. Indeterminate.

**Lucky Tiger**  
**T#10020**

**Indeterminate**- This bi-color tomato with green and yellow hues is a great little tomato for its bright and super sweet flavor! Its shape is a bit more elongated than the more petite size tomatoes, making it so unique! Enjoyed in jams, jellies, salsas, and more! Fruit size 2-4 ounces.

Huge, solid scarlet fruits average 1-2 pounds. Excellent slicer with extra delicious flavor. Indeterminate. 77 days.

**Ananas Noir (Black Pineapple)**  
**#T10022**

Flesh is bright green, yellow, purple, red mix with superb flavor that is sweet and smoky with a hint of citrus. Outsides remain green when ripe, give them the squeeze test to tell when they are ready to eat. Weighing up to 1 ½ lbs.

**Uralskiy- Dwarf**  
**T#10023**

Unique, super early dwarf plants are very well-suited for container culture. Red, 2-4 oz, mini-beefsteak shaped fruit are juicy with good flavor. Consistently one of our earliest tomatoes to ripen in the field. Uralskiy Ranniy is extremely easy to grow and produces high yields – especially for such small plants. A Russian commercial variety, when translated means “Early from Ural Baranovski of Minsk.

**Gundula- Dwarf**  
**T#10024**

Dwarf bushes, rugose regular-leaved plants produce medium-sized, 2-3 oz meaty fruit prolifically and early. Red-orange fruit grow on such a small stout plant. Very good for container gardening, as plants only reach 12-20” tall at maturity. Gundula is perfect for a pot on the porch. Originating in East Germany.

Culinary sensation. Delicious grilled or pan blistered. Prolific plants. Most are not spicy but once in a while there is a surprise hottie.



**Banana

Sweet Banana peppers are great for pickling or stuffing and frying. About 6" in length with mild to medium heat.



**Basil-Sweet**  
**#H10001**

The Italian cooking standard. Annual.



**Basil-Genovese**  
**#H10002**

Pungent classic basil flavor. Great for pesto. Annual.



**Basil-Lemon**  
**#H10003**

Smaller plants and leaves have wonderful lemony fragrance and flavor. Loves to be pruned which encourages growth. Excellent for teas! Annual.



**Basil-Lettuce Leaf**  
**#H10004**

True to the name, large leaves 6" across are lighter in color with a slightly subtler flavor than classic basil. We love to use the leaves for salads and as a wrap in the place of lettuce. Annual.



**Basil-Tulsi/Holy Basil**  
**#H10005**

Fabulous unique flavor is unlike any other basil. Used for teas and medicinally. Compact bushy plants. Annual.



**Basil-Purple Opal**  
**#H10006**

Beautiful dark purple plants are flavorful and perfect for show. Looks great in cut flower arrangements while adding basil fragrance to the room. Annual.



**Cat Nip**  
**#H10007**

Member of the mint family. Will easily reseed but does not spread by the roots. Great for tea and pleasing your feline friends. Annual.



**Flat Leaf Parsley**  
**#H10008**

You know it, you love it. The culinary staple. Annual but will reseed if allowed.



**Curled Leaf Parsley**  
**#H10009**

All the parsley flavor in a fun curly package. Annual but will reseed if allowed.



**Thyme**  
**#H10010**

Perennial. Low growing hardy plants will bless your kitchen with delicious thyme flavor that cannot be matched by grocery store shelved product.



**Licorice Mint**  
**#H10011**

Perennial. Similar to Anise Hyssop but distinct. Use for teas, salads or medicinally. Loved by native pollinators.



**Anise Hyssop**  
**#H10012**

Perennial. Fragrance and flavor is sweet anise. This is the star of the herbal tea world and loved by pollinators.



## **Oregano**

**#H10013**

Perennial. Cut and come again classic herb. Will reseed if you allow. One plant is all you will ever need. Home grown flavor does not compare to store bought.



## **Lemongrass**

**#H10014**

Lemongrass is perennial in tropical climates but can be grown as an annual in Siskiyou. Suitable in containers as long as it is deep enough to accommodate the root system. Use in cooking or tea. This year I am trying to keep one as a houseplant.



## **Peppermint**

**#H10015**

Perennial. Best grown in pots as it is very prolific and will spread by root/runners. Prefers lots of water but will grow anyway without it. Use fresh for salads and in sun tea. Dry for hot herbal tea. Our house loves to add to Thai recipes.
